



DEPARTMENT OF ENDODONTICS

To the 5th-year Dental Medicine students:

- The written test to be taken at mid-semester is **mandatory**. The **minimum passing grade is 7**, and it may be attempted twice before the first examination session.
- Students are required to fulfil the **minimum practical requirements (barem)**, which is a **necessary and compulsory condition** for admission to the practical exam. This includes: 5 teeth treated with orthograde endodontic therapy, 1 tooth retreatment, and 1 patient with simple/complicated dental lesions with pulpal-periapical involvement. Treated teeth must be accompanied by a detailed clinical sheet and pre- and post-obturation radiographs.
- **Absences** may be made up **ONLY** during the special week designated for this purpose, according to the schedule posted on the department's notice board.

The conditions for admission to the exam in the January-February 2026 session are:

Fulfilment of the minimum practica requirements (barem),

Passing the written test,

Full recovery of absences.

- **Students who accumulate up to 5 absences during the semester** (representing 20% of the total practical hours) are required to **fully make them up**, without any additional fee. If all other conditions are met (quota fulfilled, mid-term test passed), they will be allowed to sit for the Endodontics exam in the January-February 2026 session.
- **Students who accumulate more than 5 absences during the semester will NOT be allowed to take the exam** in the academic year 2025–2026 and will be required to repeat all academic activities of the discipline (lectures, practical classes, written test, and practical barem) in the following academic year.
